

LCPS Jewellery Policy

The Governing Body's Policy regarding jewellery is as follows:

We recommend that children do not wear jewellery to school.

However, we appreciate that there may be occasions when Parent/Carer may want their children to wear jewellery. In this instance the Governing Body accept no responsibility or liability for the loss, damage or safe keeping of such items. Therefore discrete jewellery (that senior staff do not consider to be a health and safety risk) will be permitted to be worn during the school day. The complete exception to this is during any PE activities.

Ideally children would not wear jewellery on days when PE activities take place, but should Parent/Carer choose for their child to do so, the jewellery must be removed by the child for the PE activity and will remain their sole responsibility.

Should any child attend school with an item of jewellery deemed to be a health and safety risk, the child will be asked to remove the item by a senior member of staff. It will then be held in safe keeping in the school office to be redeemed at the end of that day.

In the event of any disagreements regarding this policy, the Executive Head/Head of School's decision will be final.

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
