- accurately assess the physical development of children using age appropriate gross motor skill checklists
- deliver universal activities to improve children's physical development in Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1
- Deliver a daily intervention programme for children identified as in need in Year 2 and upwards
- measure the physical development progress of children taking part in the programme
- make appropriate referrals to the Childrens' Therapy Team using the fast track referral process
