

Dojo Update

We are now well into the new on line Dojo system which charts positives regarding behaviour and conduct of all learners FS2-Yr6. Following a review of how this system is going in school, it has been decided that a 'Serious Incident Form' dojo should be added. A child will only be given this dojo by myself (Mrs McMahon) as the Behaviour Leader once I have received the 'Serious Incident Form' from a member of staff.



Types of incidents may include: verbal abuse, threatening behaviour/bullying, hurting others, racial incidents and damage to belongings and property. The result will be that a child will lose 5 dojos and if necessary there may be a further consequence such as dinnertime detention.

I will add a brief note to each 'Serious Incident Form' dojo given so that parents are aware of the type of incident that has occurred. As well as a consequence for the children we hope that this dojo will encourage them to stop and think about the choices they are making and to continue to improve communication between school and parents.
