Magic Breakfast

We have been lucky enough to secure funding to start this new initiative from September. 'Magic Breakfast' means that any child who would like a free (no charge) breakfast at the start of school day can do so.

Initially we will have 1/4 of a bagel or 30g of cereal (portion controlled sizes) on offer and, depending on the uptake, other options may be organised later on. This will be available between 8.20am and 8.35 am at the 'Magic Breakfast', marquee which will be set up at the edge of the field. Children can 'grab and go' and dispose of bowls or spoons in the bins provided.

We hope that this will be a popular addition enabling children to make a positive start to the school day.

Our Lakeside Breakfast Club will open as normal in Southgate hall cost £2 for families who require this provision.
