

## Negative Consequences

Learner is given a verbal warning regarding their unacceptable behaviour  
If behaviour continues, lose a dojo.  
SIF( Serious Incident Form) completed for unacceptable behaviour (see form for categories)  
SIF dojo issued by Behaviour Lead/SLT explaining why

1. Behaviour managed within class e.g. loss of dojo, 5/10minutes payback at break or dinner, completing learning at homework club etc.

2. Dinnertime Detentions

3 occasions - Class Teacher (CT) informs parent/carers when this is reached

3. After School Detention

2 occasions - CT re-informs parent/carers when this is reached

Behaviour Leader to step in to provide support if required such as writing Behaviour Plans.

4. On Site Seclusion (at LCPS)

$\frac{1}{2}$  day, full day, 2 days

Head of School/Deputy to meet with parents to discuss unacceptable behaviour and next consequence steps.

4. Off Site Seclusion (at another school)

6. Fixed Term Exclusion -

(for  $\frac{1}{2}$  day- 45 days depending on seriousness of the behaviour)

7. Permanent Exclusion

(that must be upheld by the Governing Board)

Steps do not necessarily need following in a linear way. If a child's behaviour is deemed as intolerable they may skip some of the steps e.g. be put in seclusion straight away/fixed term exclusion.
